Be prepared for minor emergencies with our essential at-home dog emergency kit. Keep your best friend safe, happy, and healthy!

First Aid Basics

- Sterile Saline Solution (for wound and eye cleaning)
- Antiseptic Wipes or Chlorhexidine Spray
- Non-stick Gauze Pads (various sizes)
- Vet Wrap (self-adhesive bandage)

Tick and Splinter Removal

- Tick Removal Tool or Fine-Point Tweezers
- Magnifying Glass (optional, but helpful!)

Allergy and Pain Relief

- Diphenhydramine (Benadryl – dosage from your vet)
- Dog-Specific Pain Relief (never give human medications without vet approval)

Digestive Support

- Canned Pure Pumpkin (no sugar or spices)
- Probiotic Powder for Dogs
- Unflavored Pedialyte (for mild dehydration)

Miscellaneous Must-Haves

- Digital Thermometer (dog-safe)
 - Muzzle (for safety during injury treatment)
 - Emergency Mylar Blanket
 - Flashlight (preferably rechargeable)
 - Extra Collar and Leash

When to See a Vet Immediately

- Severe bleeding
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Broken bones
 - Seizures
 - Rapid swelling (especially around face or throat)
 - Unresponsiveness
